Matters arising from the Minutes of the Last Meeting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Community Speedwatch volunteers have now carried out speed checks on North Road and South Road. During this time, they have logged over 3300 vehicles with 408 reported as being over the speeding threshold. The Police have now approved an additional site on Radford Hill and a further one is being proposed for The Avenue. Passing residents have been supportive with encouraging comments. The Police provide us with reports and write to drivers who have exceeded the threshold limits. Excessive speeders can even be prosecuted. The volunteers were congratulated for their hard work and more are wanted and will be trained. SM will publicise details. • Spare keys for the defibrillator will now be held by the Clerk and the volunteer who monitors it. • A draft design plan will be suggested to the owners of the wall by the pavement on The Avenue for their comment. This would enable the widening of the pavement on the bend. B&NES Highways had clarified their role. • The idea on investigating the formal ownership of the HaHa path was discussed again. On a vote of 6 in favour and 5 against it was decided to investigate the costs involved now. 	SM Clerk DW Clerk
